

Myanmar, Malawi establish diplomatic relations

NAY PYI TAW, 15 Feb— The Republic of the Union of Myanmar and the Republic of Malawi, desirous of establishing friendly relations and mutually beneficial cooperation on the basis of the principles of the Charter of the United Nations and norms of international law, agreed to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level with effect from 30 January 2012. The Joint Communique on the establishment of diplomatic relations was signed by the Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar and the High Commissioner of the Republic of Malawi in New Delhi on 30 January 2012. Myanmar has been making efforts to expand diplomatic relations with countries all over the world and the Republic of Malawi has become the 105th country with which Myanmar has established diplomatic relations. — *MNA*
